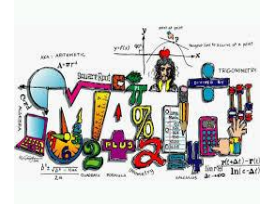


English:

The children will analyse a range of texts, covering several genres, identifying the key features and using these to produce their own pieces of writing. There will be a continued focus on Reading comprehension, and the corresponding skills, as well as spellings, punctuation and grammar.

Mathematics:

In Maths we will continue our work on number skills, including percentages and decimal numbers. We will also be looking at shape, angles, units of measure, as well as interpreting a variety of data.

**Science:**

The term in Science children will look at the biology of animals including humans. We will focus on the internal processes in the body such as circulation and digestion.

**Computing Digital Literacy and Technology:**

This term we will be working on coding websites using HTML, we shall be carrying out a range of cross curricular work including blogging, handling data and presentations.

**Art & Design Technology:**

In Art we will be linking to our topic work on Greece to study Greek architecture and use elements of this to design our own structure.

Humanities:

Our Topic this term will be Greece Lightning. The children will study both Ancient Greece and modern day Greece. They will identify and describe its geographical features, develop research questions to guide research and consider how the past influences the present. This topic will further enhance pupils' learning in English through Greek mythology and will provide opportunities for research using a wide range of media.

PE:

In PE we will be developing pupils' physical fitness, co-ordination and skill level whilst actively encouraging a positive attitude towards both themselves and others. This will be undertaken during invasion games and striking and fielding games.

**PSHE:**

In PSHE this term children will be looking at identity, society and equality. We will learn about people who have moved to Islington from other places, homelessness and human rights.
