Year 4 Library Visit

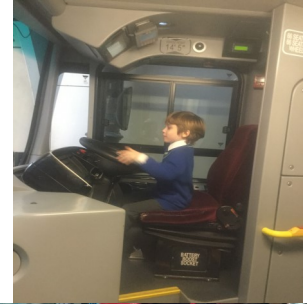
