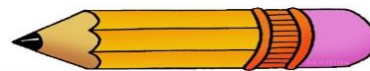

Our top tip for talking this week is: To demonstrate rather than correct. If your child says something incorrectly, repeat what they've said, but in the correct way and try to keep it in the conversation. You can do this with individual words, e.g. if they say "tat" you can repeat "ah, you saw a ...cat", or sentences e.g. if they say "dog runned" you can say, "yes, the dog ran, didn't it."
