Year 1 Parent Summary Summer Term 2020

Welcome back everyone! Below is a brief summary of some of the areas the children will be studying during the Summer term.

Religious Education

In Religious Education the children will learn about the events in the 40 days after Easter from the Resurrection of Jesus Christ to Pentecost. They will also learn about belief in the Kingdom of God as expressed in the parables. They will learn about the lives of individuals who acted in response to their beliefs such as Nelson Mandela.





English

The children will listen to and write about both fiction and nonfiction texts and we will also explore poetry once again. Some of the texts we will cover include; 'Beegu', 'Man on the Moon' and 'Amazing Grace.' Children will practice writing different text types including; recounts, information and persuasive. Children will continue to take part in daily phonics activities and regular handwriting practice. They will continue to develop their speaking and listening skills using drama and role play.

Mathematics

This term in Maths the children will continue to learn about multiplication and division, relating it to real life situations. They will be developing problem solving skills during Maths investigations. They will also begin exploring simple fractions including halves and quarters. The children will learn about measurement of time and money using correct mathematical vocabulary to explain concepts. They will also develop positional language learning about turns and directions. We will continue to use practical resources and electronic activities such as Doodle Maths to support and engage pupils in the joy of Mathematics.





Science

The Science topic this term is **'Plants.'** Children will learn to identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees. They will also begin to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. Children will explore how plants can be adapted to their environment.

Computing

In Computing the children will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. They will do this predominantly through the use of Seesaw. Later on they will also continue to develop their programming skills.



History

In History our theme is **'Space Flight**'. Pupils will learn about the history of space flight and learn to put events in chronological order. They will also learn about the lives and achievements of some significant individuals from this field, such as the British astronaut Tim Peake.





Geography

This term we will be studying the 'British Isles'. Pupils will be able to identify the five countries that make up the British Isles; England, Ireland, Northern Ireland, Scotland and Wales. They will learn about human and physical features of each country including the names of capital cities and key rivers.

Art & Design

In Art and Design the children will continue to use pencils, paints and materials to create pictures that reflect the learning across the curriculum including space craft, other world creatures, plants and flowers.





Design and Technology

Children will design, make and evaluate products linked to our learning across the curriculum such as spacecraft and vases.
