



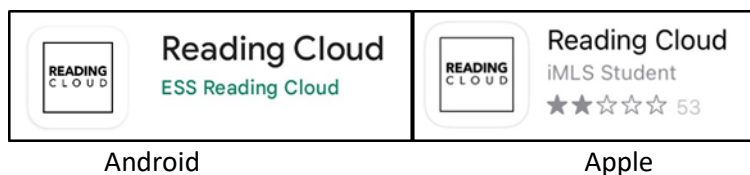
E-books and Audiobooks on the READING CLOUD library management system.

To access the READING CLOUD:

1. School website <https://st-josephs.islington.sch.uk/>
(follow the News tab to Library)
2. Library Blog link at <https://ilovereadingatstjosephs.blogspot.com/>



3. Reading Cloud URL link on any browser: <https://u015640.microlibrarian.net/>
4. Reading Cloud app by searching for Reading Cloud on the Android Play Store or the Apple App Store.



Each child has a **username and password** which has been either given to them or sent home by their class teacher.

Username: 4-digit number
Password: Child's Birthday (ddmmyyyy)



The school name should already be displayed. If it isn't then start entering the school's postcode – N19 5NE.

Once you have logged into the desktop version of the site you will be able to then log into the app using the same logon and password.
On the app, you will need to enter the school's postcode to identify the correct school.

What is Reading Cloud?

Reading cloud is a library management system with an innovative online pupil engagement community which helps schools promote reading for pleasure and helps children develop positive attitudes to reading to become lifelong readers.

Reading Cloud makes it easier for you to get involved with and support your child's reading from home. With Reading Cloud you can:



Access your Child's School Library

From any computer, iPhone, iPad, smartphone or tablet and help your child choose what to read next.



Help your Child with Book Reviews

Review books from home and give them a star rating. This is a great feature for developing your child's literacy and writing skills.



Track your Child's Reading Progress

View their past book loans and what they are currently reading.



Watch Author Video Clips

Watch video clips of authors talking about books with your child.



Be sure your Child is Networking Safely*

Reading Cloud provides a safe secure environment for your child to learn social networking skills. They can create an online profile, chat with friends, blog and be part of the Reading Cloud community.



Access Quality eBooks*

Help your child choose from a huge selection of ebooks that they can read on smart phones, iPads or tablets. Multi-lingual titles are also available for children who have English as a second language, if they're available in your school library.



Find out what they like to Read

Help your child pick their next book with the help of "Who Next" which recommends books based on what they have previously read, looking at similar authors/genres.



Create a Wish List

Search the school library catalogue to see which books are in stock before you buy new titles for your child at home.



Access Safe Websites Access approved, curriculum relevant and safe websites from home.
