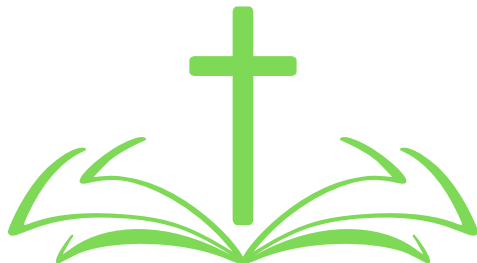

Amen.



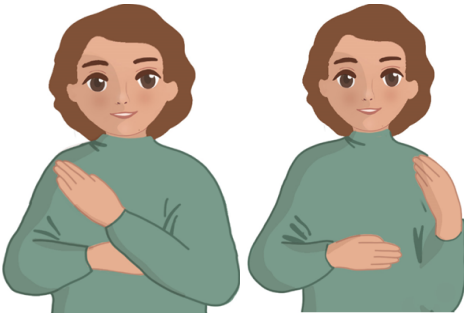

Care of Creation

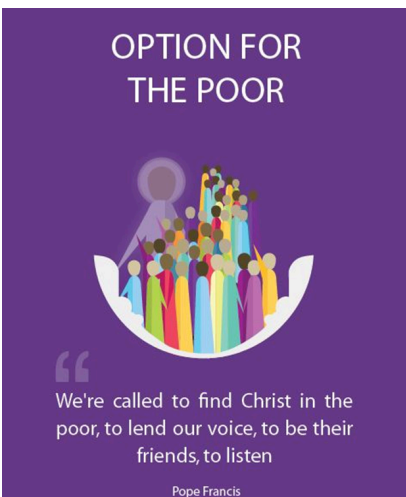
Loving God,

Amen.

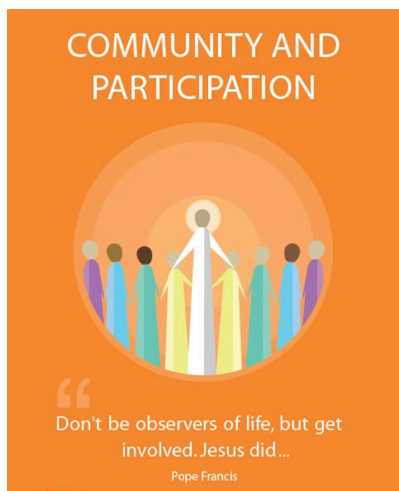


Community & Participation

Amen.



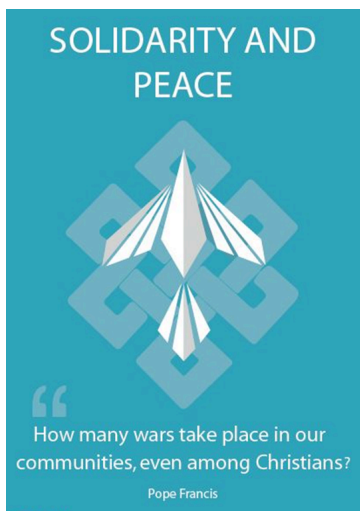
Solidarity & Peace

Help us to follow the example of Your Son, Jesus Christ, by spreading Your peace and by standing in solidarity with those who cannot speak for themselves.

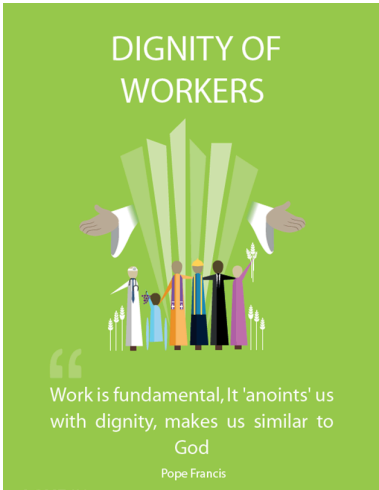

Loving God,

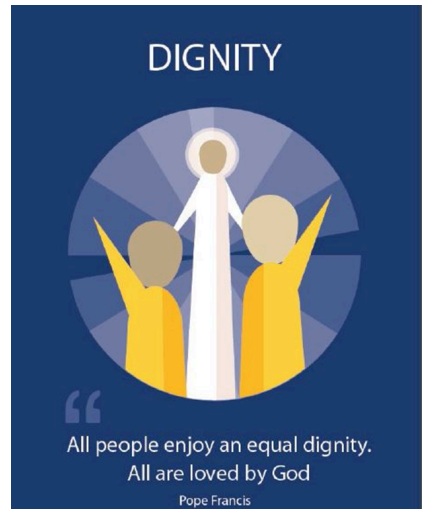
