world without end.

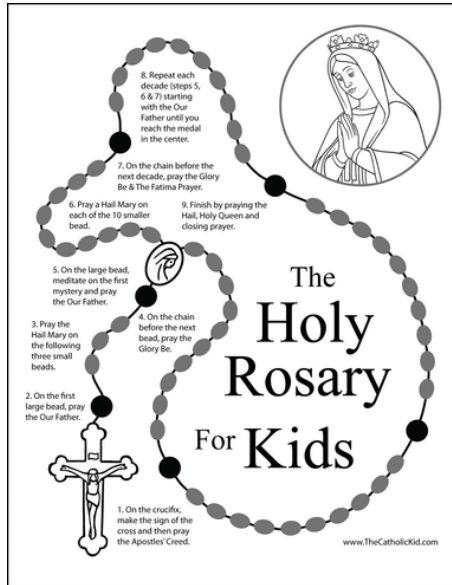

good stewards of creation.

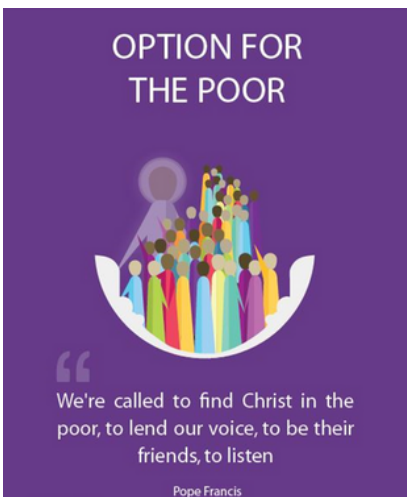

Amen.



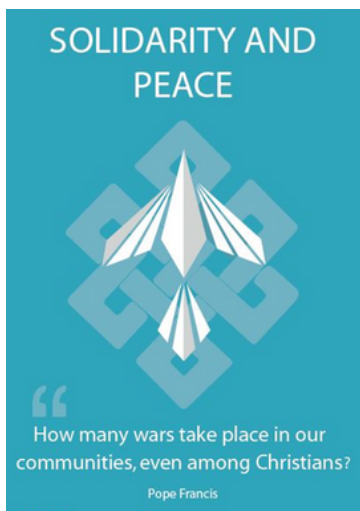
Solidarity & Peace

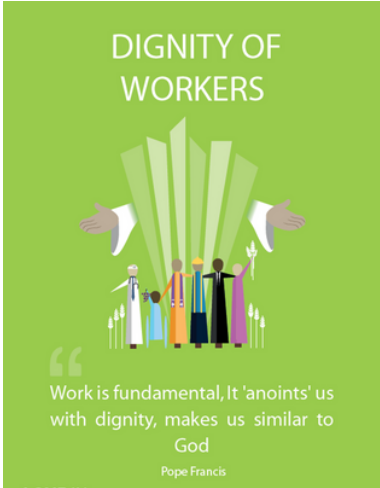
Loving God,

Amen.



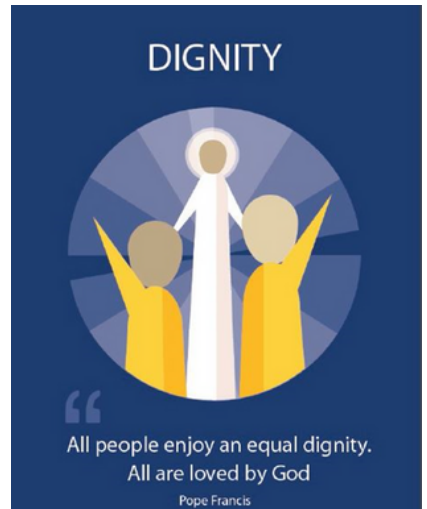


Dignity of Workers
